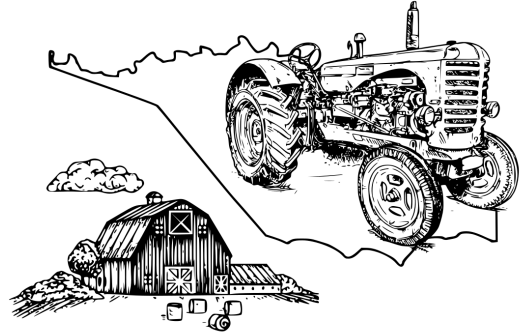

Eligibility

The Wainfleet Agricultural Society's "Fleeter Farm Kids" contest is open to all Wainfleet residents aged 18 and under. A "farm project" includes any agricultural activity in which fruit, vegetable, meat or animal product is produced and sold.

Parents' Involvement

The aim of this contest is for kids to learn about farming, business, and the merits of hard work and commitment. Parents may need to help with some aspects of the project, at the discretion of the parent.

Terms and Conditions

Prize winners will be awarded a cash prize of \$500 on or after April 15. A parent or guardian will be required to sign an acknowledgement of receipt of the prize, and accept terms and conditions, including an agreement to provide receipts for purchases made with the prize money and to prepare a poster for submission to the Wainfleet Fall Fair in September 2024.

Winners (and their parents) are responsible for following all federal and provincial regulations surrounding the sale of food products with respect to food safety, sale of meat and/or produce, taxation, etc. By entering a contest, you conclusively are deemed to have agreed to be bound by these contest rules and terms and conditions as well as by any rules specific to that contest. This is an irrevocable condition of entry. No purchase or payment of any consideration is necessary to enter the contest.
