## General Rules

- Read and adhere to Rules and Regulations of the Fair
- Entries must be brought to the cattle shed on Wednesday between 2 p.m. and 9 p.m. and remain until Saturday at 5:00 p.m. No exceptions.
- Judging will be held on Thursday, September 19, 2024.
- Space is limited! The Chairperson reserves the right to refuse entries once the capacity of the building has been reached - cages will be supplied for all poultry and rabbits.
- All exhibits shall be subject to health inspection at the time of arrival by the Chairperson and sick or debilitated exhibits shall be removed - **any animal(s) showing signs of sickness will be removed from the show immediately. This will be strictly enforced.**
- Exhibitors may show as many entries in any class as they wish.
- Any section where five or more birds are entered for competition, the Chairperson has the right to make an additional class.
- The Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage regardless of cause; all exhibits being entered are at the sole risk of the owners.
- This show will be cancelled if there are instructions from the CFIA and/or Feather Board Command Centre regarding Avian Influenza in the area.
- This show may be cancelled if there are any poultry related illness in the Niagara Region that will pose a risk to the animals attending.
- **All efforts will be made to make sure the animals are safe and secure at the show. Animals will be supervised at all times and will be cared for and fed by the Chairperson and committee. Fresh water and food will be provided throughout the duration of the show.**
