HALTER SCRAMBLE 13-21 YEARS OLD

Halter Scramble - open to boys and girls 13 to 21 years of age as of Jan 1/23 Contestants place halters all together in a pile in front of the baseball diamond backstop. On command, each finds their own halter, catches their calf and puts the halter back on, and races to a designated spot.

HALTER SCRAMBLE 12 YEARS OLD AND YOUNGER

Halter Scramble - open to boys and girls 12 years of age and younger as of Jan 1/23. The same requirements as for 14CA.

RULES

1. All cattle must have a Livestock Traceability Tag in order to participate in this event. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to provide the Tag. The Chair of the event will be responsible for expelling any cattle without a Livestock Traceability Tag.
2. Show starts on Thursday at 7:00 p.m. sharp - a must!
3. If more than 7 entries are in event, prizes given will be at the discretion of the Chairperson.
4. All sections are open to all residents of the Niagara region and Dunnville.
5. All exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up immediately after the show, including bedding, manure, hay, etc. from their exhibit or prize money shall be withheld.
